- b. Rule 19 as prescribed. All test shorn sheep must have shearing ear tags and will be inspected on the morning of the show.
- c. Exhibitors must furnish current Animal Health Declaration.
- d. Sheep showing odd teeth must be taken as advanced age.
- e. Sheep entered in a class for which it is found they are not eligible may be transferred to another appropriate class.
- f. The Judge shall have the power to disqualify & so mark any exhibit which in his opinion does not comply with the regulations & shall enter the reason in his book. In the event of any protest being upheld, the next award shall not necessarily take the higher prize. The Judge shall award or withhold it at his discretion.
- g. Sheep may be entered for only one class and under no circumstances can they be removed from one pen to another except where otherwise mentioned.
- h. Exhibits will be allowed to leave on Saturday however exhibits travelling more than 200km one way may leave earlier with the approval of the committee.
- i. The Judge may inspect exhibits prior to judging for the purpose of classification.
- j. All Champions must parade for the Grand Champion Award.
- k. Junior Champion Ram and Ewe will be selected from 1st prize winners in 2 tooth classes.
- I. Waiver must be signed by all exhibitors.
